

Ninebark

(*Physocarpus opulifolius*)

Physocarpe à feuilles d'obier

Native Shrub of the Rose Family
Hardiness Zone 2-7

Height: 1-3 m (3-10 ft) Can be pruned to maintain shape.

Habitat: Rocky and gravelly soils, dry, full sun. Low maintenance shrub commonly used as hedge/screen.

Fruit: Cluster of smooth dry fruits turn reddish at maturity in mid-August to September.



Flowers: Showy round cluster composed of numerous flowers in early summer. The many flowers are a valuable nectar source to a variety of insect species (bees, wasps, flies, moths and butterflies).

Leaves: Alternate, simple, palmately 3-lobed.
